Subject: Binn Farm Waste Proposals

I wish to register my objection to the proposed energy from waste plant and materials reclamation facility at the site of Binn Farm, Glenfarg, Perthshire. My main objections centre on the operators failure to control the sickening smell which emanates from Binn Farm at regular intervals. We moved into our house ([REDACTED] Abernethy) about 2 years ago and at first contacted SEPA quite a lot about the worrying emissions which left us unable to leave our windows open or enjoy our garden. We have not contacted SEPA recently because we felt we were not achieving anything and sometimes the smell had lessened by the time someone from SEPA checked it out, but we have continued to be aware of the operators failure to control the smell from their plant. I feel that if the operators cannot control what emanates from their current plant, they should not be allowed to go ahead with these proposals for an energy from waste plant and materials reclamation facility. As I have a young child, I am also worried about the possible health effects of the emissions from Binn Farm. No-one who has experienced the sickening smell at first hand can trust the current emissions to be harmless. How much further are SITA to be allowed to ruin the quality of life for the people here and in neighbouring villages?
