Dear Campaigner,

The Scottish Executive has 'suggested' that Perth & Kinross Council (PKC) should work with Fife Council and Forth Valley Authorities (Clackmannanshire, Falkirk and Stirling Councils) to develop a joint plan for waste management.

According to a PKC report from June (see [reports](#) page) the council now plans to compare the cost of taking up this suggestion, or sticking to their own plans. Incidentally, Forth Valley authorities have rejected incineration in favour of more recycling. If they can do it, so should PKC.

Interestingly, it seems that the Scottish Executive has told PKC it should halve its residual waste from 60,000 tonnes to 30,000 tonnes by increasing recycling. This is really going to get their knickers in a twist.
