**Objections to Proposed site for Incineration Plant at Binn Farm.**

We are writing to you to raise our concerns over the proposed site for an incineration plant at Binn Farm to which we object. This would be built at hardly any distance from our house and also very close to the new primary school at Abernethy.

We feel very strongly that it would be a health hazard as the prevailing wind brings all fallout over in our direction. Already we have had to put up with disagreeable smells at certain times and the thought of suffering from toxic ash landing around us does not appeal at all. As we are on the east side of the village, next to the lovely new primary school we are on a direct route for the fumes from the waste disposal site. Surely this is not healthy for young children! Due to the building of a new primary school only 5 years ago this has brought many young families to the village. It would not be a safe place to bring up these young and vulnerable children living in the shadow of toxic waste.

From indications from other incinerator sites there is also a serious health hazard to adult and elderly populations. When we came to live in Abernethy we wished to live in the country away from the pollution of cities! We note that your offices are situated in a location where there is no nuisance of toxic waste and we would hope that you will appreciate our grave concerns!
